















- 1) Scissors

- 3) Counters

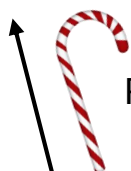
What to do:

- 1) Ask your students to get into groups of 4 or 5.
- 2) Print out a Chimneys and Candy Canes board for each group - ideally on A3 paper.
- 3) Either print out a dice per group or per student and ask your students to assemble them - remind your students not to cut off the stripy tabs, otherwise gluing the together will be tricky!
- 4) You students will take it in turns to roll the dice and must move their counter that many spaces.
- 5) The first student to reach the top wins!
