Step 1: Go to the admin area and click on **Competitions and Live**. Then select “Go to Competitions”.

Step 3: Give your competition a name and then choose the classes you want to take part. You will only see classes assigned to you as a teacher, but you can use the “View All School Classes” to see all the classes on the platform.

You can select one class, multiple classes, or you can use the “Select All Classes” button.

Step 4: Now choose the dates you would like your competition to run. Select the dates on the calendar, and then set the start and finish time. You can set up competition for weeks, days or even a few hours! Then click “Submit Competition”!

NB: Your school can only take part in one competition at a time. If you see the trophy 🏆 icon, it means a Languagenut competition is taking place! We'll send you out more information about these competitions beforehand!

Only one competition can run at a time with Languagenut Competitions showing in your calendar as 🏆. During these competitions students around the world can compete to win Amazon vouchers - or equivalent. When you create your own competition, the 🏆 icon will appear.
