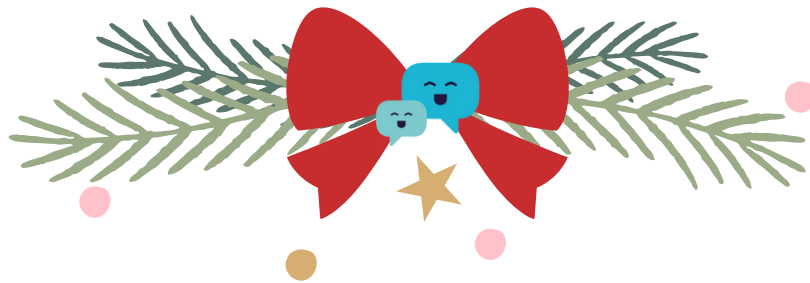


Nougat blanc	Candied fruits (citrus peel, cherries, melon)
Amandes	Almond-paste candy from Aix-en-Provence or other local sweets
Pommes ou poires	Dates
La pompe à l'huile	Candy or chocolates
Calissons	Apples or pears
Fruits confits	Sweet bread made with olive oil and orange blossom
Les quatre mendiants	Figs
Bonbons ou chocolats	Dried fruits representing four monastic orders: almonds, walnuts, hazelnuts, raisins
Figs	Walnuts
Dattes	Almonds
Noix	Dark nougat made with caramelized sugar and almonds
Nougat noir	White nougat made with honey, sugar, and almonds



Answers

- Les quatre mendiants – The Four Mendicants (dried fruits representing four religious orders: almonds, walnuts, hazelnuts, raisins)
- Amandes – Almonds
- Noix – Walnuts
- Figues – Figs
- Dattes – Dates
- Nougat blanc – White nougat (honey, sugar, almonds)
- Nougat noir – Black nougat (darker, caramelized sugar, almonds)
- Fruits confits – Candied fruits (citrus peel, cherries, melon)
- La pompe à l'huile – Olive-oil brioche, flavored with orange blossom
- Pommes ou poires – Apples or pears
- Bonbons ou chocolats – Candy or chocolates
- Calissons ou autres douceurs régionales – Calissons (almond-paste candy) or other regional sweets
